## Statutory Declaration

(No Will, No Probate Intestate – Two Claimants)

This Declaration is to be made before a Magistrate, Solicitor or a Commissioner for Oaths.

1. That Holder of the Grant purchased the exclusive Right of Burial of grave/plot number XX in Pencombe Cemetery.

3. That the said Exclusive Right of Burial has not been sold, transferred or otherwise dealt with.
